HOW LONG WILL MY APPRENTICESHIP LAST?

An apprenticeship can last from 12 months to four years. Generally Level 2 apprentices will have a 12 - 14 month contract, Level 3 apprentices will have an 18 month contract and for Level 5 & 6 this can be between two and four years.
